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











Conifers account for around **one half** of the woodland area in the UK overall, but the proportion varies in each country.







# Frequency of visitors to UK woodland




51% of the UK public experienced an increase in their level of happiness when in woodlands and 43% an increased connection to woodlands in the 12 months since March 2020








The total area of native woodland in Great Britain is estimated to be around 1.5 million hectares

### Carbon



Carbon stock in UK forests is estimated to have increased, from around **3.2 billion tonnes** of carbon dioxide equivalent in 1990 to **4 billion tonnes** of carbon dioxide equivalent in 2020. Woodland Carbon Code projects\* are estimated to sequester 5.7 million tonnes of carbon dioxide over their lifetime
