






Conifers account for around **one half** of the woodland area in the UK overall, but the proportion varies in each country.

New planting (000 ha)





Restocking (000 ha)










Production of wood products decreased by 3% for sawnwood, 9% for wood-based panels and 6% for paper and paperboard between 2019 and 2020

Gross value added in forestry and primary wood processing (£ million)



Employment in UK forestry and wood processing



Frequency of visitors to UK woodland










Native trees account for around **one half** of total woodland area in Great Britain, but this varies in each country.



Since 2015 the population of woodland specialist species has **fallen** by 10%




Carbon

Carbon stock in UK forests is estimated to have increased, from around **3.2 billion tonnes** of carbon dioxide equivalent in 1990 to **4 billion tonnes** of carbon dioxide equivalent in 2020.
