


Chart 1: Softwood Utilisation in Main Markets in the UK, 2003-2007




Chart 2: Softwood Utilisation in Main Markets by Volume, 2006 & 2007







Chart 4: Index of Softwood Imports & UK Housing Starts, 1967-2007





Chart 6: Estimated Softwood Consumption in the New Housing Market, 1995-2007





Chart 8: The Changing Mix of Dwelling Types Built in the UK New Housing Market, 2004-2007





Chart 10: Estimated Softwood Consumption in the RMI & Other Construction (Non-New Housing) Market Sectors, 1988-2007
