

Chart 1: Softwood Utilisation in Main Markets in the UK, 2003-2006









Chart 3: Total Softwood Consumption and All Construction Output, 1970-2006





Chart 4: Index of Softwood Imports & UK Housing Starts, 1967-2006





Chart 5: Estimated Softwood Consumption in the New Housing Market in the UK, 1970-2006





Chart 6: Estimated Softwood Consumption in the New Housing Market, 1995-2006





Chart 7: Softwood Consumption in New Housing Starts, 2003-2006





Chart 8: The Changing Mix of Dwelling Types Built in the UK New Housing Market, 2003-2006





Chart 9: Estimated Softwood Utilisation in the Housing RMI Market & Volume of Housing RMI, 1998-2006




